The high school senior applying for this educational grant must complete the application personally. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant. No written notification will be sent to applicants except those selected. Submitting an application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted. There is no appeal, and the decision of the selection committee is final.

Eligibility/Requirements

All applicants must:

- Be a Cranford resident.
- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Submit applications via mail or email no later than 3/28/2024.

Note: if using the CHS Common Application, please only fill out page 5. Also please do <u>not</u> send the Income Information requested in section F, as we do not consider financial need during our review.
